Rodent Concerns



For property owners having a problem with rodents the following is a short list of actions to prevent occurrences of rodent infestations;

1. Maintain a clean and refuse free property.
2. If you need to feed pets outside, leave small amounts at a time.
3. Ensure that access to outbuildings (garage/shed) and skirted decks is prevented and/or monitored regularly.
4. Piles of wood or other materials which could be burrowed under should be supported off the ground a minimum of 6".
5. Mobile home owners should ensure that skirting is maintained in good order and the skirted area is monitored for signs of rodents such as droppings, chewed material and burrowing.
6. Under no circumstances should straw bales be used for insulating around homes.

These pro-active actions will go far in preventing a rodent problem within your property. Contact the Town Office or Animal Control 204-734-4586 to report any concerns.

Water Efficiency Tips for Your Home

- Avoid running the water for long periods when brushing teeth, shaving and washing.
- Fill a cup or the sink with some water when doing these tasks and you could reduce water use for these tasks by 60 to 80%.
- Try taking short showers instead of a bath.
- Install a low-flow shower head.
- Washing full loads in the dishwasher saves more water than hand washing the same amount of dishes.
- When hand washing dishes, partially fill one sink for washing and the other for rinsing. If you have only one sink, place washed dishes in a dish rack and rinse them all at once with a spray of water.
- Wash only full loads of laundry, but avoid overloading the machine. Upgrading to a front-load washer will decrease this water consumption by 60%.
- Upgrade all toilets to a good quality dual flush system. This will decrease home water consumption by 20 to 25%. Vast improvements have been made in low flush technology.

You can pick up a free copy of the "Household Guide to Water Efficiency" booklet at the Town Office to learn more great water saving techniques.

Please use caution when driving around or near Town of Swan River street crews and construction sites. They are working to better your services. Please be patient, go slow, obey signs and barricades. Thank you.
