

Rodent Concerns

For property owners having a problem with rodents the following is a short list of actions to prevent occurrences of rodent infestations; 1.Maintain a clean and refuse free property.

2.If you need to feed pets outside leave small amounts at a time. 3.Clean excess material from beneath birdfeeders to limit food sources. 4. Ensure that access to outbuildings (garage/shed) and skirted decks is prevented and monitored regularly. 5. Piles of wood or other materials which could be burrowed under should be supported off the ground a minimum of

6. Mobile home owners should ensure that skirting is maintained in good order and the skirted area is monitored for signs of rodents such as droppings, chewed material and burrowing.

7. Under no circumstances should straw bales be used for insulating around homes.

For the most part the first action will go far in preventing a rodent problem on your property. Contact our office or Animal Control 734-4586 to report any concerns.

Please keep lids closed on Garbage **Dumpsters and Cans to stop pests from** getting into garbage.

All residential and commercial garbage must be in proper containers as per Town of Swan River By-law No. 5/2013.







Pet owners are asked to feed their pets indoors, or not leave food outside for extended periods 🥰 of time which attracts unwanted pests. We thank you for your co-operation.

Sewage Flushing Concerns



The flushing or drainage of material other than human waste and gray water within a public sanitary sewer system is prohibited. Large items such as disposable diapers and clothing/towels are causing problems within our sewage lift stations by jamming pumps and limiting our pumping capacity within these stations. We also remind residents never to dump hazardous materials such as paint and solvents into the sewer system as these items are injurious to the piping, pumping and dumping zones within the system. We appreciate your cooperation in preventing these potentially costly or dangerous situations.

Reminder

By-Law No.3/98 -Being a By-Law of The Town of Swan River providing authority to control and regulate parking of campers,



boats, and trailers, mobile homes, fifth wheel trailers and utility trailers on the roads and streets.

No person shall park any trailer on a road, street, or lane or boulevard for more than 7 consecutive days or for more than 14 days in a 365 day period.
