Used Oil Recycling Depot

Just one litre of used oil can contaminate up to one million litres of fresh water. Help us protect this valuable resource. Don't just throw away your used oil, filters, and plastic containers - recycle at the used oil recycling depot, located at the Swan River Landfill Site.

Used oil materials contain small quantities of substances that could contaminate air, soil and ground water. They may contain trace metals, chlorinated solvents, gasoline, polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons, glycols and PCBs. Plastic containers are not biodegradable and take up valuable landfill space.

But, when collected, used oil, filters and plastic containers can be recycled and reprocessed into useful products instead of becoming an environmental threat.

DUTCH ELM DISEASE

To prevent the spread of Dutch Elm Disease please Do NOT trim Elm trees from April 1st – July 31st.

The time to trim your trees is now!

During summer months beetles are active and would be attracted to open wounds making your tree more vulnerable to Dutch elm disease. Provincial monitors will be in Town during mid-August. If you have any trees of concern you may contact the Town Office to be placed on the inspection list.



UNACCEPTED MATERIALS

Please do not place any of these items in your blue bins:

- Aluminum foil, foil pie plates or foil food containers
- Dishes, ceramics or crystal
- Electronics
- Foam packaging of any kind
- Paint cans or oil cans
- Paper towels, tissues or napkins
- Plastic bags or cellophane
- Steel pots and pans or scrap materials
- Wax or foil coated paper
- Window glass, mirrors or broken glass

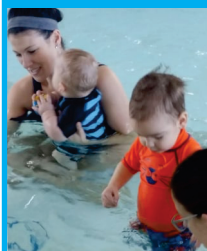
