## JUNE - Public Works Construction Projects:

**Main Street Utility Replacement Project -** Town crews will begin the watermain and utility service replacement between PTH 83 and the CN crossing on Main Street. The public shall expect detours, please slow down and be aware of construction workers and vehicles. Business access in the construction zone will be maintained through the back lanes and other residential streets.

**Various Sidewalk repairs –** Public Works Crews will be repairing sidewalk areas around Town, Please watch your step.

**Curb and Gutter installations –** On all previously excavated areas in preparation of hot mix asphalt.

**Line Painting –** line painting (white) operations will be pushed up in 2020, expect a painting crew around Town painting white road markings.

Please be advised that for all persons going to the landfill that Section 61(2) of the Highway Traffic Act states that: No person shall operate, or permit to be operated, upon a highway any motor vehicle or trailer unless the load that the motor vehicle of trailer is carrying is firmly bound, sufficiently covered, or otherwise secured or loaded, in such a manner that no portion of the load may become dislodged or fall from the motor vehicle or trailer.

## Used Oil Recycling Depot

### Why a used oil program?

There was a time when people didn't think twice about simply throwing away or dumping oil products. Today, we are more aware that careless disposal methods not only harm the environment, but also waste a valuable non-renewable resource.

Each year, about 215 million litres of new oil are sold across western Canada. Yet slightly more than half of that oil is not consumed during use and is available to be recycled.

And it's not just used oil that presents a hazard to the environment if it's improperly discarded. After you pour the oil into your car, boat, lawn mower, tractor or other motors, there is residual oil in the plastic containers that can be recovered.

Used oil filters and plastic oil containers can also be recycled into other useful products. With a program and proper return facilities now in place, western Canadians can:

- Recover more used oil, filters and containers.
- Extend the life of a non-renewable natural resource.
- Provide the recycling industry with oil, plastic and steel.
- Decrease pollution caused by improper disposal. Reduce the amount of non-biodegradable materials in our landfills.

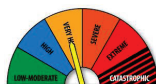

Burning bans have been ordered in surrounding Municipalities, but not yet in Town.



Please follow a few tips if you must use your fire pit this weekend:

1. Do not burn if it's windy
2. Clear away all dead grass and twigs from your fire pit area
3. Keep your fire pit covered with a spark arresting grate
4. Don't build fires with high flames, those flames carry sparks and spread them over a large area
5. Never leave a fire unattended and have something close-by to put it out if necessary (e.g. Water hose)
6. Put your fire out completely using water and by stirring and soaking the hot coals.
7. Please DO NOT use Fireworks in any areas where dry conditions exist.
